LIMIT POLICE UNION CONTRACTS

On May 1, 2021, Virginia will allow public employee labor unions to negotiate contracts with collective bargaining.

POLICE UNIONS can use collective bargaining to **prevent** accountability for police brutality and misconduct. Currently, Virginia police are rarely charged with a crime following the death of a civilian.

Collective bargaining can further limit accountability for police brutality or misconduct by allowing:



PURGING records of misconduct



LIMITING disciplinary consequences



DISQUALIFYING civilian complaints

Percentage of police officers charged with a crime following a civilian death: Virginia 2013–2020¹


